



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION/REGULATIONS/PRIVACY POLICY

EUNSUREING THE SAFETY OF ALL PARTICIPANTS IS OUR HIGHEST PRIORITY. BELOW, YOU WILL FIND THE CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION, APPLICABLE REGULATIONS, AND INFORMATION REGARDING OUR PRIVACY POLICY

*Age participant:

- For the e-bike fox hunt, the age-group classifications are determined according to the official announcement
 - Participants must be at least 12 years old to take part in the e-bike fox hunt
 - The age limit is calculated based on the year of birth 2014.
 - To check the minimum age, it is mandatory to present an official photo ID at the start number distribution!
 - Anyone under the age of 18 requires the consent of a parent or legal guardian (signature of the legal representative)
1. Each participant acknowledges that participation involves inherent risks and that the Paznaun – Ischgl Tourist Office, as the organizer, cannot ensure the participant's safety.
 2. Aware of the risk, the participant declares that in the event of damage or injury, he will not assert any claims for compensation of any kind against the Organizer.
 3. The participant confirms that he has valid personal liability insurance and a valid personal leisure accident insurance that covers his participation in the e-bike fox hunt. He will indemnify and hold the organizer harmless for all damages incurred by him because of his participation in the e-bike fox hunt.
 4. The Participant assumes full responsibility for the equipment used by them and acknowledges that the Organizer is under no obligation to inspect or monitor the Participant's equipment.
 5. The Organizer accepts no liability for any lost valuables, clothing, or equipment.
 6. Commercially available eMTBs (Pedelecs) with pedal assistance up to a maximum speed of 25 km/h and a maximum continuous rated power output of 250 watts are permitted. In accordance with the "EN 15194:2017 Pedelec (EPAC) Standard", an exceedance of the maximum pedal assistance speed of 25 km/h by up to 10% (i.e. up to 27.5 km/h) is tolerated. If this threshold of 27.5 km/h is demonstrably exceeded during an inspection, this will result in disqualification (DSQ) without exception.
 7. The Organizer is not responsible for any reduction in performance resulting from the Participant being wholly or partially prevented from participating due to legal regulations and/or official orders.
 8. It is hereby agreed that the Organizer's liability in cases of ordinary negligence shall be limited to the scope and amount covered by the Organizer's liability insurance.



9. The Participant undertakes to comply with all competition and safety regulations communicated to them by the Organizer.
10. The participant agrees that his personal and address data as well as results will be stored by computer and processed for the purposes of conducting and handling the event. This also applies to the payment processing of necessary data. In particular, through our partner RaceTimePro GmbH Timing Solutions (service provider for sporting events). 11. The processing of the data referred to in point 10 is carried out exclusively by the organiser and its partner Datasport Partner RaceTimePro GmbH Timing Solutions (service provider for sporting events). Disclosure to third parties is excluded.
12. The participant agrees that his name, year of birth, place of residence and team may be published in the start and result lists on the Internet (www.ischgl.com/e-bike-wm, <https://www.ebikewm.com/> and <https://www.racetime.pro/>), in the newspaper and on notices.
13. The participant agrees that the organizer may take photos, video and TV recordings of the participants in connection with the event. These recordings can be used by the organizer without any claim to remuneration and may also be passed on to third parties and may be used in time, place and without limitation. This applies in particular to marketing purposes (including public relations and press work) for the E-Bike Fox Hunt and the E-Bike World Championship for Everyone (also for the following years).
14. The participant agrees that important information (e.g. route changes; changes in start times, etc.) before and after the event.
15. The participant may object to the processing of his or her personal data with effect for the future. The objection must be declared in writing (e.g. letter) or in text form (e.g. by fax or e-mail). Please state your surname, first name, your team and - if known - your start number in your objection. We would like to expressly state that if photos and videos and other personal data are published on the Internet or social media, they will be removed immediately from the websites accessible to us in the event of a revocation on our part. However, for technical reasons, a comprehensive deletion of your published data cannot be guaranteed.
16. In the event of cancellation of the event due to force majeure (e.g. bad weather), official regulations (e.g. Covid-19), non-attendance or interruption of the race for reasons beyond the organizer's control, the participant is not entitled to a refund of the participation fee or compensation for other damages, such as travel or accommodation costs. Furthermore, the organizer is entitled to shorten or change the routes and change the time limits in the event of bad weather or other unforeseen events.
17. The organizer has the right to exclude participants who behave improperly in any way from the race



18. The participant knows that doping is the deliberate manipulation of the body in order to achieve better performance and thus leads to exclusion from the event.
19. In case of danger, cancellation or interruption is possible by the organizer, rescue service and also by the authorities.
20. The Organizing Committee may decide at any time to accept, reject or exclude an entrant from the Contest if his or her participation may damage the image of the Event.
21. Final permission to take off may be subject to a positive on-site inspection or safety check.
22. If desired, participants can take out cancellation insurance directly at the time of registration. If no cancellation insurance is taken out, there is no right to a refund of the entry fee. Each participant takes out the cancellation insurance directly with the insurance company (Europäische Reiseversicherung). If it is not possible to start the e-bike fox hunt and a refund of the entry fee is demanded in the course of this, this must be clarified directly with the insurance company. Participants will find the general insurance conditions directly at the time of registration.
23. A medical examination is recommended.
24. Wearing a crash helmet is mandatory. This must comply with the ANSI/Snell or the new TÜV/GS standards.
25. Participation with the bib number of another participant or any other incident determined by the organization will be punished with exclusion from the competition. The participant is excluded from the event for another two years.
26. The sale or auction of a starting place, whether via internet platforms such as Ebay or by any other means, is strictly prohibited. Every offer for sale will be followed up and both buyer and seller will be prohibited from participating in the e-bike fox hunt for life.
27. By registering for the e-bike fox hunt, the participant confirms the correctness of the data he has provided.
28. If the race is stopped, the participant must report to the nearest marshal/medical service and hand in his race number.
29. Prize money and non-cash prizes will be awarded exclusively on the occasion of the official award ceremony. After the end of the award ceremonies, the participant loses any claim to prize money or non-cash prizes. The participant must be personally present at the award ceremony. Substitutes will only be accepted after prior consultation with the organizing committee and are only allowed in absolutely exceptional cases.
30. The medical service present along the route and at the finish is free of charge for the participants. Prescribed helicopter missions are at the expense of the participant. The medical service or the competition management has the right to remove participants with insufficient equipment or those who are at risk of harming their health from the race for a certain period of time or permanently.



31. All provisions of the Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) apply on all routes during the entire race.
